Why Cultural Responsiveness Matters

Behavior Interpretation Check

Before labeling a behavior as problematic, ask:

- Is this behavior actually harmful, or just different from my expectations?
- Would I interpret this behavior the same way from all students?
- Am I considering the cultural context of this behavior?
- Have I consulted with family about cultural norms?
- Is my discomfort about the behavior or about difference?

Equitable Practice Checklist

- Behavior expectations are clearly taught, not assumed
- Consequences are applied consistently across student groups
- Data is disaggregated to identify disparities
- Positive strategies are tried before exclusionary discipline
- Family communication is culturally appropriate
- Student voice is included in behavior planning
