## Understanding Setting Events

Setting events are conditions that make a behavior more or less likely to occur. They don't directly trigger behavior but set the stage. The same antecedent may lead to very different behavior depending on setting events.

## Pattern Analysis

After 2-3 weeks, look for patterns:

- Does behavior increase after specific setting events?
- Which setting events have the strongest correlation?
- Can any setting events be prevented or addressed?

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### Automatic Pattern Detection

Classroom Pulse tracks setting events and automatically identifies correlations with behavior.

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
